

Conditions of Entry ...2/

9. ENTRY FEE The fee is \$10 for the first piece of art \$5 for second piece, a cost of \$2 for entries 3 and 4 and \$1 for the 5th entry. A maximum of 5 works per artist will be accepted by the organizers of the SF NSW 25th Anniversary Art Prize.

10. SIZE OF ARTWORK The maximum size of works entered into the Art Prize including frame is 1.50mx1.33m=2m². 2.00mx1.00m=2m²

11. PREPARATION OF ARTWORKS Work must be presented ready for exhibition. ie mounted and framed. The artist's name, address and phone number, title of work, price of work must be clearly marked on the back of each work and on the entry form.

12. RECEIPT OF ENTRIES Work will be received at the Schizophrenia Fellowship NSW Inc, Building 36, Digby Road, Gladesville on 28 and 29 October between 10am and 4pm

13. COLLECTION OF ARTWORKS Collection location, date and time will be advised shortly and documented on the SF NSW website.

14. CARE AND RESPONSIBILITY SF NSW 25th Anniversary Art Prize organizers will exercise all reasonable care with works submitted but will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any work while in its custody or in transit.

15. COPYRIGHT SF NSW 25th Anniversary Art Prize organizers reserve the right to photograph works exhibited in the Art Prize for the purpose of documentation and promotion. All necessary acknowledgements of authorship will be duly made. The artist has sole responsibility for ensuring the work submitted does not infringe any relevant copyright Laws.

16. INTERPRETATION OF THE RULES The decision of the judge/judging panel is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

17. Wet or late entries/deliveries will not be accepted.

SF NSW 25th Anniversary Art Prize

The SF NSW 25th Anniversary Art Prize is an acquisitive award for painting, drawing, print-making, collage, photography, sculpture, textile and jewelry.

The award and exhibition will be one of a number of events in 2010 raising awareness of the 25th Anniversary of the formation of the Schizophrenia Fellowship in New South Wales and its commitment to improving the circumstances and welfare of people with a mental illness, their relatives and carers.

People with schizophrenia have made art for centuries; some influencing art styles whilst others have found audiences and markets for their work.

The intention of the Art Prize is not to romanticise the relationship between certain kinds of conditions and artistic talent but illuminate the business of living with a serious mental illness and raise political and community awareness of the many facets of living with schizophrenia.

Conditions of Entry

1. ELIGIBILITY The SF NSW 25th Anniversary Art Prize is open to all schizophrenia sufferers and carers being a resident of New South Wales.

2. MEDIUM The SF NSW 25th Anniversary Art Prize is open to original paintings in any medium such as watercolour, acrylic and oil, other mediums such as drawing (pencil, pastel, charcoal etc) printmaking and collage. Photography, sculpture, work in textiles and jewelry are also accepted.

3. SUBJECT For the SF NSW 25th Anniversary Art Prize the subject of the work/s submitted is entirely open to the artist. The work/s are required to be created within the past eighteen months.

4. PRIZE The prize/s will be awarded on the advice of the Judge/Judging panel.

5. ACQUISITIVE PRIZE The SF NSW 25th Anniversary Art Prize winning work shall remain the property of the Schizophrenia Fellowship NSW Inc. The artist retains copyright. SFNSW must be acknowledged on any reproduction of the prize-winning work.

6. EXHIBITION SELECTION The SFNSW 25th Anniversary Art Prize organizers reserve the right to withhold from exhibition any work/s unsuitable for installation in the Art Award.

7. EXHIBITION All works of art are to remain on exhibition for the entire duration of the exhibition and required to be for sale

8. SALE OF ARTWORKS The SFNSW 25th Anniversary Art Prize organizers will deduct 10% commission from the sale of artworks to assist with the costs of presenting the 2010 Award.
