The Sunflower Clinic is a specialist service tailored to the needs of people affected by psychosis, and their cares.

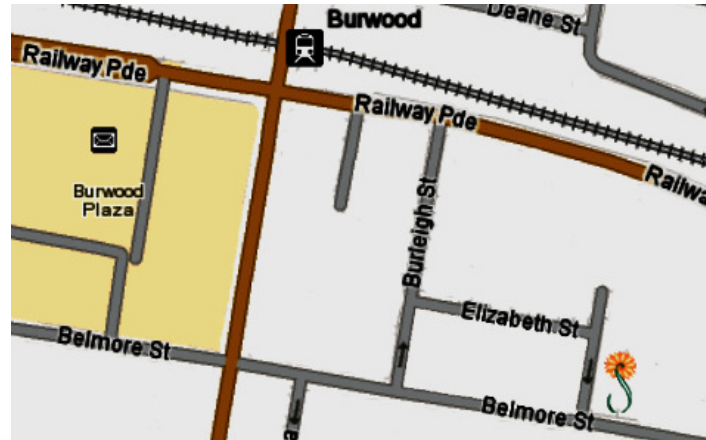
At Sunflower Clinic, we understand the complex needs which can arise from living with a severe or persistent mental illness.

Services Available

The Sunflower Clinic offers compassionate psychological services to individuals, adolescents, adults, families and carers affected by psychosis.

We offer a range of services to improve your wellbeing and enhance your quality of life, all within a recovery framework.

Services available include:

- Individual counseling
- Family therapy
- Couple therapy
- Supervision
- Professional training
- Consultancy

We also have links with Disability

Employment Services and Respite Services, in

addition to other relevant recovery based programs.

What types of Issues?

Symptoms of psychosis can be very distressing to individuals experiencing them. These symptoms can also impact upon carers and families.

At Sunflower Clinic we can help you with

- managing symptoms of psychosis
- early intervention
- relapse prevention

From time to time you or your loved one may also experience a variety of additional issues that can

Impact on recovery. These include:

- Stress
- Depression
- Anxiety
- Behavioural issues
- Family and relationship issues
- Workplace or employment issues
- Self esteem issues
- Grief and loss

The number of sessions you require will depend on the nature of your concerns. Your psychologist will discuss what is most suitable with you.

Making an Appointment

If you would like to make an appointment or need more information, please contact the clinic.

Referrals from individuals, family members or other health professionals or agencies are welcome.

Fees:

Fees will be discussed prior to your appointment. Rebates are available through:

Medicare: Medicare rebates are now available to all Medicare card holders. An appropriate doctor's

referral is required in order to be able to claim through this scheme. Contact the Clinic or speak with your doctor for further details

Private Health Funds: Many private health funds offer partial rebates for some psychological services. Check with your health fund for details.

Cancellation Fees:

A minimum of 24 hours notice is required if you are unable to attend your appointment. If minimum notice is not provided you will be billed for the full fee of your appointment.
